# **Powerhold General Purpose Adhesive**

### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Powerhold General Purpose Adhesive is hard setting, water based flooring adhesive. It can be used to install commercial and domestic PVC planks and tiles. It is also suitable for use on sheet vinyl floorcoverings and carpet.

#### **SURFACE PREPARATION**

All surfaces to be bonded should be dry, smooth, and free of any contaminates. All surfaces must be prepared in accordance with current relevant Australian Standards 1884-2012 Floor Coverings Resilient Sheet & AS2455 including moisture testing. It is recommended that all highly absorbent sub floors be primed with MJS Max Prime Acrylic Floor & Wall Primer prior to the application of adhesive. Note: Substrate must be absorbent to allow adhesive to dry and cure.

The minimum sub floor temperature prior to commencing preparation or adhesive application is 10°C.

#### **APPLICATION**

Vinyl - spread adhesive with a 1.6mm x 1.6mm x 1.6mm 'V' notched trowel.

Carpet – spread adhesive with a 2.4mm x 2.4mm x 2.4mm 'V' notched trowel.

Lay the floorcovering into a wet adhesive film. Always check to ensure that complete transfer of adhesive to the floorcovering has occurred.

Complete installation according to flooring manufacturer's instructions, ensuring the installation is rolled in both directions with the recommended roll weight, prior to the adhesive curing. Do not allow heavy traffic for 24 hours.

# **CLEAN UP**

Clean tools immediately after use with warm soapy water. Dried adhesive on tools may be cleaned off using a solvent cleaner applied to a damp cloth then rubbed gently over the dried adhesive.
